INDEX OF NAMES, ANONYMOUS WORKS AND PLACES

Names of ancient authors, medieval authors writing in Latin, popes, emperors and saints are given according to the Latin orthography (e.g. «Augustinus», not «Agostino», «Augustine», «Augustin»; «Bonifacius VIII», not «Bonifacio VIII», «Caetani, Benedetto», etc.). Names of medieval authors writing mostly in vernacular, modern authors and places are given in the language of their provenance (e.g. «Boccaccio» not «Boccace»; «Paris» not «Parigi») and uniformed according to the normal instruments of reference (e.g. *Dizionario biografico degli italiani*, etc.). Members of the same family are listed under this latter. Names mentioned in documents and otherwise unknown are given according to the orthography attested in the document, between French quotation marks (e.g. «Andreatius»). Other names are given in English (e.g. modern geographical definitions). Textual works are listed under the authors' names, if known, and under their titles, if anonymous. Artistic works and manuscripts are listed under the institutes of conservation, with the few exceptions of works whose current locations are unknown and which are to be found under the name of the artist.
